

Zamit and the Future Foundation Research Grant for Teachers

Zamit believes that teachers play a significant role in influencing and guiding school students to become future-ready in this VUCA world. To encourage teachers to remain up-to-date with the latest changes in the area of future readiness and to continuously find new and innovative ways to help students succeed, Zamit, in association with The Future Foundation, a not-for-profit body, offers research grants to independent teachers to carry out original research.

Eligibility and Access

The research grant is available to primary and secondary school teachers with at least three years of relevant teaching experience and demonstratable skills in implementing new and innovative teaching and mentoring methods. Teachers also need to demonstrate being able to effectively support at least 50 school students on their journey towards future readiness. The research grant will consist of INR 15,000 cash support per teacher. In addition, Zamit and its academic partner QAI, UK will also provide support and advice to the selected participants during the process of completing their research.


Research Requirments

Teachers must undertake independent and original research that must be linked to Zamit's Nine Dimensions for Students and provide recommendations that can be practically and easily implemented as part of the teaching and learning process in schools. The research must also consider the recommendations of the NEP 2020 that encourage integrating future-ready skills as part of subject learning.

Application Process

- a. One teacher must only submit one research proposal.
- b. Interested teachers must submit a research proposal to Zamit as a PDF document by email at connect@zamit.one or by WhatsApp on +91. 9625 440 440 by 31st March 2023 at the latest.
- c. The research proposal must include the research hypothesis and the proposed plan of research in no more than 500 words.
- d. All submissions will be screened by a screening committee appointed by Zamit and its academic partner QAI, UK.
- e. Successful participants will be notified by email by 30th April 2023 along with the necessary steps to proceed.
- f. The research must be completed within three months of receipt of the grant by the teacher.

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
