The iSKiL (International Skills & Knowledge Integrated Learning) Programme is a meticulously designed co-curricular programme for students from classes 5 to 11 mapped to the Regulated Qualifications Framework (RQF) in England, Wales and Northern Ireland and certified by QAI, UK.

The programme integrates skills development within the context of curricular subjects, enabling students to excel in a rapidly evolving world. Backed by three years of research and trials, this comprehensive programme is aligned with the Common International Framework of Reference for Future Readiness (CIFR), which defines over sixty skills, competencies and abilities categorised into Nine Dimensions across eight levels, starting at A1 for elementary-level students and progressing to D2 for individuals with expert-level skills and knowledge.



Zamit uses a proprietary Artificial Intelligence (AI) driven model based on its proprietary concept of Measure-Improve-Monitor (M-I-M) when delivering the iSKiL Programme and provides the outcome as a ZQ (Zamit Quotient) score.




The Highlights of the iSKiL Programme

- Suitability: designed for students of classes 5 to 11 as a co-curricular programme
- Duration: 60 hours for classes 5 to 10 and 130 hours for class 11
- Delivery: at school, face-to-face during school hours, or online, delivered by Zamit trainers or by school teachers trained and certified by Zamit
- Global Framework: derived from the CIFR's Nine Dimensions, using Zamit's proprietary Al-driven Measure-Improve-Monitor model – the Gold Standard for Future Readiness
- Measurement: Al-driven and adaptive measurement and analysis of over 60 skills of the CIFR's Nine Dimensions across eight levels, starting at A1 for elementary-level students and progressing to D2 for individuals with expert-level skills and knowledge, resulting in a ZQ score
- Improvement: 26 trainer-led sessions of 35 minutes each and about 35 hours of guided learning (103 hours for class 11) that include developmental activities, quizzes, competitions, videos, podcasts, reading material, formative assessments, assignments, project work and internship opportunities to help develop and improve over 60 skills in the context of subject learning
- Monitoring & Impact analysis: continuous monitoring of engagement with an impact analysis to track performance and improvement at individual, class, school and country level
- Learning Power: helps build learning power the key to academic excellence and becoming a self-directed, lifelong learner
- Portfolios: provides a platform to create, update and maintain a personal portfolio of academic and non-academic achievements
- Scholarships: offers an opportunity to participate in the Annual Future Readiness Scholarship carrying a pool of INR 5 lacs
- ZQ Mapping: ZQ mapped to the CIFR's Nine Dimensions, which includes the skills, traits, aptitudes and competencies recommended by both the NEP 2020 and the International Baccalaureate (IB)
- Global Standards: mapped to the Regulated Qualifications Framework (RQF) in England, Wales and Northern Ireland (UK's regulated qualification framework) and certified by QAI, UK








ZQ (Zamit Quotient) and its Nine Dimensions
