

Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL)

During this course, you will

- examine why the use of CLIL is deemed essential for 'the teacher and school of the future';
- develop a working understanding of successfully integrating CLIL into your own teaching.

How to be an Effective Teacher

In this programme you will

- examine the relationship between the teacher and the learner and learn how to adopt a student-centred approach when teaching;
- explore the concept of self-directed learning for teachers and learners;
- receive guidance about effective monitoring and providing objective feedback to your learners;

- consider teaching using a range of innovative resources and authentic materials.

◀ Innovative Assessment Methods

In this programme you will

- examine a range of innovative tools and methods that can make continuous assessment engaging for students;
- evaluate methods and technologies for innovative assessment and feedback in terms of their efficacy and appropriateness for different settings and learners;
- evaluate interactive assessment tools that deliver fine-grained, timely and dialogic feedback and learn how to employ self-reflection and peer grading in teaching and learning.

◀ Innovative Teaching Methods

In this programme you will

- explore teaching outside of the confines of the classroom walls;
- learn how to foster learning in informal settings and how to use everyday life experiences to spark interest in your students;
- evaluate methods and technologies for supporting innovative teaching and learning in terms of their efficacy and appropriateness for different settings and learners;
- consider teaching without the use of published materials, critically examine a range of innovative resources and review the use of authentic materials in the classroom.

Competency-Based Teaching and Learning (CBE)
